




Nearby Tourist Destinations



Shri Shiv Samarth Gadh



Dervan, located near Chiplun in Ratnagiri district of Maharashtra, is a renowned spiritual and cultural tourism destination. It is associated with Shri Sant Sitaram buwa Walawalkar and has developed into an important pilgrimage centre. The highlight attraction is Shiv-Srushti, a grand memorial dedicated to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj showcasing his life through magnificent sculptures and historical displays. The campus also houses serene temples including Shri Ram, Shri Swami Samarth, Shri Hanuman, and Shri Dattatreya temple. Surrounded by the scenic beauty of the Konkan region, Dervan offers a peaceful spiritual atmosphere. It is an ideal place for visitors to experience heritage, Patriotism, history, and spirituality.



Ganpatipule

The Ganpatipudhe temple has *Swayambhu* murti situated near the beach. Every year thousands of devotees across Maharashtra visit the temple. The murti is facing West, Ganpatipule town is rich in flora, it has plenty of mangroves and coconut trees. It is situated in a small town which have about 100 houses. The beach present near the town is a popular tourist destination. Approx 70 Kms away from conference venue.



Marleshwar Temple

The Marleshwar is an ancient temple built and dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. It is also called as village of 100 waterfalls. The entire temple has been constructed inside a cave with pleasant views of the valleys. 520 steps must be climbed to reach the temple. Approx 42 Kms away from conference venue.



Guhagar Beach

Guhagar Beach is a popular, clean, and relatively quiet beach located in the Ratnagiri district of Maharashtra, India. It's part of the Konkan coast and is known for its calm waters, white sand, and surrounding greenery, including coconut and betel nut plantations. The beach is a good option for those seeking a peaceful getaway and a chance to experience the traditional culture of Kokan. Approx 50 Kms away from conference venue.
